<b>Name of the activity</b>	<b>Sustainability playing cards</b>
<b>Topic Covered</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Main aspects/strategies about sustainability</li> <li>• Awareness on the different governance aspects</li> <li>• Biodiversity and environmental technological effects</li> </ul>
<b>Learning Outcomes and Competences that can be acquired</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Improve the environmental advocacy of participants</li> <li>• Enhance a critical approach to environment</li> <li>• Recognise the main benefits about sustainability</li> </ul>
<b>Duration</b>	1.5 hour
<b>Kind of Method</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Non-formal education</li> <li>• Interactive discussion</li> </ul>
<b>Required Materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sustainability cards (ratio: 1 deck-5 people)</li> <li>• Chairs/Tables</li> <li>• Papers/felt pens</li> <li>• Scissors</li> <li>• Scotch tape</li> </ul>
<b>Learning Setting and Activity Description</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Introduction: Before the activities starts, it is important to leave papers and felt pens on each table. The trainer introduces the playing sustainability cards as a tool to discuss about the main subjects and topics. Each card has a task or a discussion point. In this way, each group is free to discuss them.</li> <li>2. The trainer gives 45 minutes and let participants discuss about the topics they like.</li> <li>3. The trainer can encourage participants to be creative to achieve their tasks, and at the same time can be part of the table discussions</li> </ol>





<b>Activity Evaluation/ Reflection</b>	<p>After the discussion, make sure to give everyone post-its. They can write on them from 1 to 5 (1: not at all – 5: yes, a lot). They will be able to put them under each statement, so the trainer can measure how everyone felt during the discussions, and from here the facilitator can start further conversations.</p> <p>Write on a flipchart (prepare them beforehand):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I feel I have learned new concepts I was not aware of</li><li>• I believe climate change is not only a matter of individual choice, but collective effort</li><li>• Technology plays a crucial role in the green transition</li><li>• Technology has more positive aspects than bad aspects</li><li>• I think I will improve my green behaviour</li></ul>
