<b>Name of the activity</b>	<b>Eco-Investment Treasure Hunt</b>
<b>Topic Covered</b>	Identifying green investment opportunities
<b>Learning Outcomes and Competences that can be acquired</b>	Improve the ability to identify green investment opportunities in everyday life.
<b>Duration</b>	45 minutes
<b>Kind of Method</b>	Interactive Treasure Hunt
<b>Required Materials</b>	Timers, notepads and pens List of green investment items or initiatives prepared by the educator.
<b>Learning Setting and Activity Description</b>	Participants are given a list of everyday items or environmentally friendly initiatives that can be considered green investments, such as LED light bulbs, solar panels or community gardens. The group is divided into teams and the challenge is to find as many items as possible within a time limit. The team that finds the most items wins.
<b>Activity Evaluation/ Reflection</b>	How can identifying everyday green investments contribute to your financial decisions? Did you enjoy the competitive nature of the treasure hunt?
