



<p>Activity Evaluation/ Reflection</p>	<p>Activity:</p> <p>“4 Guard rants of intergenerational collaboration”</p> <p>Materials:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Papers 2. Pens <p>Instructions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. The participants will work individually. 4. Ask them to separate their paper into 4 (like creating a cross in the middle, see example below). 5. Ask them to answer one question in each guard rant: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Something that they will keep about intergenerational collaboration. b. How do you personally connect with this issue? c. A step that they will take/follow for environmental change through intergenerational collaboration. d. What environmental change they want to see next years. 6. Encourage participants, if they are willing, to share their reflections and thoughts with the group. This sharing can be done in pairs or small groups to foster further discussion and support. 7. Conclude the reflection activity by summarising the key messages and expressing appreciation for participants' commitment to addressing climate change through intergenerational collaboration.
